In order to reduce the possibility of accident, prospective operators must go through forklift training by a licensed instructor before utilizing a forklift. All aspects of lift truck operation are included in training programs. The limitations and abilities of the machinery are included, along with pre-operation checks, basic operating procedures and ways of warning other personnel that a forklift is in the work place.

Lessons comprise the placement of the trailer tires and chock blocks, the arrangement of pallets in order to spread out the load right, and inspections required prior to driving into a trailer at a dock site. Courses likewise comprise Material Safety Data Sheet (or MSDS) training. Though not related directly to the use of a forklift, MSDS training is important if an operator damages a container containing toxic materials, or notices a leaking container. MSDS sheets list the correct ways of handling spills, the products and their effects on individuals.
